This letter has been written by your local Safer Neighbourhood Team. We have recently had several concerns raised around parking and certain interactions at Weston on Trent Primary school.

Reports vary between parents causing obstructions across driveways, through to parents having verbal arguments in front of children. This is **not** acceptable behaviour.

We appreciate that drop off and collection of the pupils can be a stressful time for all involved, with time constraints and the layout of the surrounding roads.

With that in mind, we remind you that if you block a resident's driveway and refuse to move, you are committing an **offence**.

Repeat offenders will be open to being ticketed. Please ensure you drive and park with consideration to residents. The situation will be monitored going forward.

Our priority in this situation is the safety of those attending the school and the easing of any potential tensions the current parking is causing.

If you experience any kind of anti-social behaviour during school pick up times, please report it via 101 or on the Derbyshire Constabulary Website.
